<u>Recommendation</u>: Yes. AmeriSteel has alleged that a significant reduction (approximately \$440 million) to FPL's base rates is appropriate. If, after consideration of the evidence, the Commission determines the requested actions are appropriate, significant rate reductions will occur. Given the magnitude of these proposed reductions, an expedited hearing is appropriate.
