Issue 1: Should Aloha Utilities, Inc. be required to refund excess grossup collections for 1993-1996?

Recommendation: No. The utility does not owe refunds for 1993-1995. For 1996, the utility over-collected CIAC gross-up in the amount of \$2,859; however, staff recommends that the Commission accept Aloha's request to offset 50% of the legal and accounting fees incurred (\$3,050) against the refund amount of \$2,859. Although the utility is entitled to offset \$3,050, only \$2,859 of this amount will be used to offset the refund of \$2,859. When the offset is made, no refund is required for 1996.
