MOTION OF MCIMETRO ACCESS TRANSMISSION SERVICES, INC. TO EXPEDITE HEARING SCHEDULE

MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc. ("MCImetro") moves that the hearing schedule in this case be expedited and that a hearing be held and an order issued by June 30, 1998 or as soon thereafter as possible. As grounds for its Motion, MCImetro states the following:

- 1. MCImetro filed its Complaint on February 23, 1998. The Complaint includes several claims relating to the Operations Support Systems ("OSS") provided by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), as well as claims relating to trunk blockage reports, local tandem interconnection, flat-rate usage data, directory listings and BellSouth's soft dial service. Many of the claims raised in the Complaint seek to address deficiencies noted in the Commission's order dated November 19, 1997 ruling that BellSouth failed to meet the fourteen point checklist of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, 47 U.S.C. §§ 151 et seq.
- 2. The Interconnection Agreement (the "Agreement") between MCImetro and BellSouth provides that the Commission has continuing jurisdiction to implement and

enforce all terms and conditions of the Agreement and that any dispute arising out of or relating to the Agreement may be submitted to the Commission for resolution.

Agreement, Part A, ¶ 23. The parties agreed "to seek expedited resolution by the Commission," and to "request that resolution occur in no event later than sixty (60) days from the date of submission of such dispute." Id. MCImetro sought expedited resolution in its Complaint pursuant to the Agreement.

- 3. On March 20, 1998, the Commission issued a case schedule calling for, among other things, a hearing on October 8-9, 1998 and the issuance of an order on December 21, 1998.
- 4. MCImetro has sought aggressively to penetrate the Florida local telephone exchange market, but has faced major obstacles, several of which MCImetro seeks to remedy in the Complaint. Delaying resolution of MCImetro's claims until December will significantly impede its ability in the interim to bring local competition to the Florida market.
- 5. As reflected in Exhibits A-F of the Complaint, MCImetro has been attempting for some time to resolve the disputed issues with BellSouth. Although some discovery may be required, the parties are generally familiar with the issues and do not require six months to prepare for the hearing.
- 6. MCI recognizes that, as a practical matter, it is no longer possible for the Commission to resolve the claims within the 60-day target set forth in the Interconnection Agreement. MCI nevertheless urges the Commission to revise the schedule for this proceeding in a manner that will accommodate both the Commission's calendar and the parties' need for a speedy resolution of the Complaint.

For the foregoing reasons, MCImetro respectfully requests that its Motion be granted and that a revised and accelerated schedule be prepared that calls for a final order to be issued by June 30, 1998 or as soon thereafter as possible.
