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## Special Service Area Agreement

Per Chapter 376.307, Florida Statutes (F.S.), the Department of Environmental Protection, Water Supply Restoration Program (hereinafter referred to as the "Water Supply Program") is authorized to expend funds from the Water Quality Assurance Trust fund to restore or replace contaminated potable water systems. This statute provides for subsidies to connect these potable water supplies to existing public water supply systems or extensions thereof, provided that no such subsidy shall exceed the present worth of the 10-year cost of providing and maintaining filters for the residents served by the connections. In addition, the provisions of this Chapter authorize funding for potential contamination where potable wells will likely be installed. The 10-year present worth cost of providing filters to homes with contaminated wells and to one-half of the developable vacant lots in the Sebring Lakes Subdivision is \$250,000.00. Therefore, under the authority of Chapters 376.307, F.S., the Water Supply Program agrees to contribute \$250,000.00 toward the construction of the water system and the connection of the homes listed in Attachment A to the Heartland Utilities water system. These funds shall include all fees associated with each of the 18 connections, including the tap fee of \$500.00 per connection and, where required by DEP, a \$150.00 fee for a Reduced Pressure Zone backflow preventer (RPZ).

The total fees to be paid by the Department for these connections shall not exceed \$11,700.00. The difference in the total funding available and the maximum connection fees to be paid by the Department is \$238,300.00. This amount shall be applied to the engineering and construction costs associated with the main extension, estimated to be approximately \$320,000.00.
