Thank you for your correspondence dated May 20, 1998, concerning FCWC's request to recover litigation costs. The Commission has scheduled a customer service hearing for July 15, 1998 in Fort Myers. This customer service hearing will permit customers to provide testimony to the Commission, which will become part of the official record for this case. FCWC will send its customers another notice, which will include the location and time of this customer service hearing. This notice will be sent at least 14 days prior to the scheduled date, but no more 30 days prior to the scheduled date.

In addition to the customer service hearing, the Commission will hold a technical hearing in ACK . Tallahassee for the purpose of hearing testimony and evidence from various expert witnesses AFA sponsored by the parties to this proceeding, including the Office of Public Counsel who has APP intervened on behalf of the citizens. The technical hearing is scheduled for August 12 through 14. CAF -1998. The Commission's technical hearing will also be open to the public. Lastly, your letter has CMU \_\_\_\_\_been placed on the correspondence side of the docket file where it will be available for review.

CTR Your letter also mentions concerns about a "Lee Co. sewer charge". It must be noted that Lee EAG -County Utilities is not under this Commission's jurisdiction. In your area, FCWC only provides water service. FCWC provides the county with the amount of water consumed during each billing LEG \_ period in order for the county to assess its charge for wastewater service.
