## TELEPORT COMMUNICATIONS GROUP INC./ TCG SOUTH FLORIDA'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF RESPONSES TO APRIL 13, 1998 STAFF DATA REQUEST

Teleport Communications Group Inc. and its Florida affiliate, TCG South Florida, referred to herein collectively as "TCG", by and through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes and Rule 25-22.006(4), Florida Administrative Code, submits this Request for Confidential Classification of TCG's Responses to Staff's April 13, 1998 data request. TCG filed its confidential responses with a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification on May 22, 1998. In support of this Request, TCG states as follows:

1. On May 22, 1998, TCG provided information to Staff concerning the number of business subscribers and the number of business subscriber lines TCG serves in Florida. This information directly relates to TCG's competitive interests. Disclosure of this information would impair TCG's competitive business interests by informing competitors of the number of business subscribers and the number of business subscriber lines served by TCG in Florida. This information is intended to be and is treated by TCG as proprietary and confidential. TCG requests that this information be classified as "proprietary confidential business information" within the meaning of Section 364.183(3)(e), Florida Statutes (1997). The Commission previously has determined that this

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type of information is entitled to the protection of Section 364.181(3), Florida Statutes (1997). See Order No. PSC-97-1039-CFO-TL and Order No. PSC-1392-CFO-TL, issued in Docket No. 960786-TL.

2. TCG requests that the information for which it seeks confidential classification remain confidential for a period of at least 18 months as provided in Section 364.183(4), Florida Statutes (1997).

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, TCG respectfully requests that its Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
