Issue 2: Should IBE be ordered to show cause in writing, within 20 days, why it should not remit RAF's in the amount of \$312.57 as well as a statutory penalty in the amount of \$78.14 and interest in the amount of \$162.54, for violation of Sections 350.113 and 367.145, Florida Statutes and Rule 25-30.120, Florida Administrative Code, for failure to pay regulatory assessment fees from January 1, 1993 to September 7, 1993? Recommendation: No. A show cause proceeding against IBE should not be initiated. Staff further recommends that the Commission refer IBE's unpaid regulatory assessment fees and associated penalties and interest to the State of Florida Comptroller's Office for permission to write off the account as uncollectible.
