Dear Mr. Cox:

I read the article in the Orlando Sentinel, Wednesday, June 10, 1998, proposing changes in the phone area code system. I would like for you to consider the following as one of your possible solutions mentioned in the article.

Please use a different area code for your beepers, fax, and pagers; ultimately, businesses, if necessary, for additional area codes. Businesses should have a separate area code; it's a separate activity. This will make more numbers available and easily identifiable as what kind of phone number you are using. I have had several clients give their fax number when I have needed their business/home number. When this happens, I have to depend on them to be registered in the phone directory. If you need to cancel an appointment, reschedule appointments or service that they expect, and they are not listed, this can be a very big problem. I feel if our phone system uses the separate area code for businesses and business machines, it may have alerted me and eliminated the problem.

This proposal would result in many other opportunities to use separate area codes for business and business machines that would assist everyone in their use of the phone system.
