4. Time Warner intends to require a deposit as a condition of service or may collect advance payments for more than one month of service.

5. Time Warner possesses the requisite financial resources and income to provide assurance of continued operation under its certificate over the long term.

6. Time Warner AxS of Florida, L.P., is an affiliate of the Time Warner, Inc., family of companies which together constitute the largest media and entertainment company in the world. Time Warner, Inc. achieved record financial performance in 1997 and is set to break that record again in 1998. As such, Time Warner has access to the financial resources necessary to effectively provide telecommunications services. In fact, in Florida, Time Warner is certified as an Alternative Access Vendor (AAV), as Alternative Local Exchange Company (ALEC) and an Interexchange Company (IXC).
