

SECOND MOTION FOR FURTHER EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

All American Telephone, Inc. (All American), by its attorneys, hereby moves the Commission to further extend the date for submission of its response to the order to show cause issued by the Commission in the above-captioned docketed proceeding. In support of this motion, All American states as follows:

By order issued February 10, 1998,¹ the Commission directed All American to show cause in writing within twenty days of the order's effective date as to why it should not be subject to sanctions for violation of Rule 25-4.118, Florida Administrative Code.² The deadline for responding to the order to show cause was to have been March 2, 1998.

Counsel for All American and the Commission Staff have been engaged in discussions in an attempt to resolve the issues set forth in the order to show cause without proceeding to hearing. On February 26, 1998, All American, by its undersigned counsel, filed with the Commission a motion requesting a fifteen day extension of time to respond to the order to show cause until March 17, 1998. Staff counsel was consulted in advance of the filing of that motion for extension of time, and indicated that Staff would not oppose that request.

Following a series of settlement discussions between All American and Staff, on March 9, 1998, All American submitted to Staff a formal proposal for settlement of this proceeding. Following additional discussions between All American and Staff, All American submitted a revised settlement proposal on June 19, 1998. On August 11, 1998, the Commission issued Order No. PSC-98-1086-FOF-TI captioned Notice of Proposed Agency Action, Order Rejecting Settlement Offer and Order Granting Motions for Extension of Time to Respond to Order to Show Cause. In that order, the Commission rejected All American's settlement proposal and directed All American to respond to the order to show cause within twenty days of issuance of that order (i.e., by August 31, 1998).

Following the Commission's agenda conference of July 21, 1998 at which the Commission voted against acceptance of All American's settlement offer, All American and Staff again met to discuss proposals for settlement of this matter. By letter dated July 24, 1998, All American submitted yet another revised settlement proposal. That revised proposal remains under consideration by the Commission Staff. So far as All American is aware, Staff has made no determination regarding its latest proposal and no recommendation has been submitted to the Commission.

In order to permit the ongoing settlement negotiations to continue without prejudicing the interests either of All American or Staff, and in order to avoid the need for the parties to submit further requests for extension of time pending Staff and Commission consideration of All American's latest settlement proposal, All American hereby respectfully moves the Commission for further extension of time to respond to the Order to Show Cause in this proceeding until

twenty days following a Commission determination whether or not to approve All American's most recent settlement proposal.
