Gentlemen:

I received this address in BellSouth's telephone bill mail out a couple of days ago and have been guite dismayed at what happened to me today.

On August 14, 1998, I called BellSouth to tell them to drop AT & T as my long distance carrier, as I heard on Nightly Business Report that they were going to start charging \$3.00 per month for long distance customers. When I paid my BellSouth bill a couple of days ago, I deducted \$1.88 they (AT &T) put on my bill as a connection charge when I didn't even use my long distance. I also called AT & T to ask them to deduct this amount and they said something about blocking my telephone number. I hardly over call long distance and informed BellSouth that I would use 10-10-321 if I needed to call long distance. The previous month for AT & T, I was charged .95 for the connectivity charge calling long distance for Father's Day.

I went to use my telephone today at 6:00PM, and my phone/s did not work; no light, no dial tone, no nothing. I had to go out and use another phone to call BellSouth to tell them my phone was not working. I do not see how AT & T has the right to block my local service or any service. I assume they are BellSouth's lines; and I am quite upset that this is happening.

If someone is not calling long distance, (the initiator), there AFA shouldn't be any charges on your bill for long distance and your local carrier (BellSouth) shouldn't hold you hostage for the APP charges a long distance carrier puts on your bill (interest on the CAF charges included). You should also be able to receive long distance calls on your telephone. I would assume BellSouth could and CMU would handle all calls made in Florida to anywhere in Florida. CTR
