1	Q.	Please state your name and business address.
2	Α.	My name is Vernon I. Krutsinger. My business address is Peoples Gas
3		System, a division of Tampa Electric Company, P .O. Box 2562, Tampa,
4		Florida 33601-2562.
5	Q.	By whom are you employed and in what capacity?
6	Α.	I am employed by Peoples Gas System, a division of Tampa Electric
7		Company, as Manager of Energy Conservation.
8	Q.	Are you familiar with Peoples Gas System's energy conservation
9		programs?
10	Α.	Yes. As Manager of Energy Utilization, I work with the Company's energy
11		conservation programs on a daily basis.
12	Q.	Are you familiar with the costs that Peoples incurs in implementing its
13		energy conservation programs?
14	A.	Yes. I am responsible for planning, implementation, coordination, and
15		maintenance of all of Peoples' energy conservation programs. My
16		responsibilities include routinely testifying in support of the Company's
17		energy conservation cost recovery filings.
18	Q.	Have you previously testified in proceedings before the Florida Public
19		Service Commission?

1	A.	Yes. I have testified in a number of energy conservation cost recovery
2		proceedings beginning in 1992. I have also testified in other conservation-
3		related dockets before the Commission.
4	Q.	What is the purpose of your testimony in this docket?
5	Α.	My testimony addresses the costs that Peoples has incurred and expects to
6		incur, and the revenues recovered and expected to be recovered by Peoples
7		through the energy conservation cost recovery clause, attributable to the
8		Commission-approved conservation programs of Peoples Gas System. My
9		testimony supports the revenues and expenses incurred and projected to be
10		incurred in connection with the conservation programs of both the former
11		Peoples Gas System, Inc. (the costs of which are recovered under Peoples'
12		Volume 1 Tariff) and the former West Florida Natural Gas Company (the
13		costs of which are recovered under Peoples' Volume 2 Tariff). I will
14		hereinafter refer to the territory within which the Volume 2 Tariff applies as
15		Peoples' "West Florida Region."
16		Specifically, this part of my testimony addresses the adjusted net true-
17		up amounts associated with those programs for the period October 1997
18		through March 1998.
19	Q.	Are you sponsoring any exhibits with your testimony?
20	Α.	Yes. I am sponsoring Exhibit (VIK-1), which contains the
21		Conservation Cost Recovery True-Up Data in the format requested by the
22		Commission Staff for the period October 1997 through March 1998 for
23		Peoples' divisions other than the West Florida Region, and Exhibit
24		(VIK-2), which contains similar information for the same period for Peoples'

1		West Florida Region. Exhibit (VIK-1) consists of twenty pages and
2		includes summary and detailed data relating to the true-up, conservation
3		revenues, and actual and projected program costs for Peoples' divisions other
4		than the West Florida Region. Exhibit (VIK-2), consisting of twenty
5		pages, includes the same information for Peoples' West Florida Region.
6	Q.	What are the Company's true-up amounts for the period October 1997
7		through March 1998?
8	Α.	With respect to Peoples' divisions other than the West Florida Region, as
9		shown on Schedule CT-1 of Exhibit (VIK-1), the end-of-period net
10		true-up for the period is an overrecovery of \$836,117, including both
11		principal and interest. The projected true-up for the period, as approved by
12		Commission Order No. PSC-98-0403-FOF-EG, was an overrecovery of
13		\$341,204 (including interest). Subtracting the projected true-up overrecovery
14		from the actual overrecovery yields the adjusted net true-up of \$494,913
15		overrecovery (including interest).
16		With respect to Peoples' West Florida Region, as shown on Schedule
17		CT-1 of Exhibit (VIK-2), the end-of-period net true-up for the period
18		is an overrecovery of \$253,399, including both principal and interest. The
19		projected true-up for the period, as approved by Commission Order No.
20		PSC-98-0403-FOF-EG, was an overrecovery of \$106,596 (including interest).
21		Subtracting the projected true-up overrecovery from the actual overrecovery
22		yields the adjusted net true-up of \$146,803 overrecovery (including interest).
23	Q.	What do the rest of the schedules in Exhibits(VIK-1) and
24		(VIK-2) show?

1	A.	Schedule CT-2, in each of the exhibits, presents an analysis of the variance
2		between actual and estimated energy conservation program costs for the
3	S.	period October 1997 through March 1998. Each exhibit's Schedule CT-3
4		presents an analysis of program costs, by month and by program, and
5		calculation of the true-up and interest amounts. Schedule CT-4 is not
6		applicable to Peoples. Schedule CT-5 provides for a reconciliation and
7		explanation of differences between the Company's filing and the
8		Commission's audit for the relevant period, and there are no such differences
9		to report as of the date of this filing. Each exhibit's Schedule CT-6 contains
10		Program Progress Reports for each of Peoples' approved energy conservation
11		programs.
12	Q.	Does this conclude your prefiled direct testimony regarding Peoples'
13		requested true-up amounts attributable to the conservation programs

approved by the Commission for Peoples Gas System?

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
