Dear Mr. Leonette:

The Commission received your response to my June 24, 1998 deficiency letter on August 13, 1998. Your letter was responsive to most of the deficiencies, clarifications or corrections in my original letter. However, the following items still need to be addressed in order for the application to be complete.

Deficiencies

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Financial Ability. As you know, Rule 25-30.034(1)(d), Florida Administrative Code, 1. requires a statement of financial ability to continue to provide utility service. In your response to my first letter of deficiency, you indicated that you are relying on the development company to loan the utility money to keep going. If this is the case, then please ACK \_\_\_\_\_ provide financial statements for the development company along with a letter of intent from AFA the development company that indicates its willingness to support the utility until appropriate rates can be established by the Commission.

Land Ownership. As you are also aware, Rule 25-30.034(1)(e), Florida Administrative CMU \_\_\_\_2. Code, requires that the utility either own, or have long-term lease to, the land upon which CTR \_\_\_\_\_ the utility treatment facilities are located. The original application contained a 99-year lease EAG \_\_\_\_\_ by the utility of the land and facilities from Rivers Edge, Inc. Also, the documents listed as Exhibits C and E in your original application show that Rivers Edge, Inc., bought 110 acres, LEG for \$1,550,000 from Ernest E. and Zola M. MacLachlan on December 14, 1990 and that E LIN warranty deed was conveyed to Rivers Edge, Inc. In my June 24, 1998 deficiency letter, a OPC NT NUMBER copy of that warranty deed was requested. 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In response, a Mortgage Deed in the amount of \$80,000 from Rivers Edge, Inc., back to the MacLachlans was provided. This deed states that a prior mortgage is superior to the Mortgage Deed being provided. In order to satisfy Rule 25-30.034(1)(e), Florida Administrative Code, staff needs a copy of the warranty deed issued from the MacLachlans to Rivers Edge, Inc., on December 14, 1990.

The original and four copies of the response to the information requested in this letter should be filed with the Commission as soon as possible but no later than <u>October 22, 1998</u>.
