40 of these being full service operation of wastewater treatment systems. They employ professional personnel and have received awards from various agencies for their operations and safety record. The Utility will continue to employ Davis Water Analysis for these purposes in order to ensure continued quality of wastewater treatment services and to expand the operations personnel utilized as required in order to meet all applicable environmental regulations."

We have reviewed the territorial description that was included with Attachment "A" to your letter and we believe it is correct and includes both the new areas and the territory already granted to the Utility. We believe this does simplify the Utility's proposed service area and have included it in the attached notice and in the attached revised tariff sheets (revised Exhibit "D" attached) in order to reflect the new and combined territory.

With these revised exhibits and information, we now believe that all of the deficiencies have been corrected. Because of the need to move forward with providing service to those area which we are proposing to serve and because the need there is immediate, we request that the Commission expeditiously approve the extension application at this time. If there is anything we can do to help speed the process along, please let me know.
