Video Tape 3 --- It is clear that the Commissioners voted to grant oral argument on both 13A & 13B (GR dissents). This is issue 1 on staff recommendation in DN 980283 (13A) and issue 2 on staff recommendation in DN 980509 (13B). RAR erred by leaving this item off the vote sheet and misnumbered the remaining numbers in item 13B. (Please note the agenda page clearly stated in bold letters "interested persons may participate at Commission's discretion").

Video Tape 4 --- Chairman Johnson clearly states that the motion to Deny staff on the declaratory statements applied to 13A & 13B. The motion to deny staff was passed on a 3 to 2 vote (JN & DS dissent).

After the break the Chairman called for clarification on the votes. The Commissioners reviewed their votes issue by issue. On 13A, Issue 1 was incorrectly identified as having been a unanimous vote. In fact, it was passed on a 4 to 1 vote with Commissioner Garcia dissenting on the oral arguments (Issue 1 - 13A & Issue 2 - 13B).

Item 13 B -- The Commissioners approved staff for Item 1 (to deny intervention); Denied Declaratory Statement on a 3 to 2 vote (Jn, DS dissent); Motion to dismiss was moot; Closing of docket was approved.
