Dear Mr. Kupinsky:

The purpose of this letter is to determine whether Telenet of South Florida wishes to pursue its Petition for relief under Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 with respect to rates, terms and conditions for interconnection with BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., in Docket No. 970730-TP.

Based on information provided to me by staff in the Division of Communications Certification and Compliance Section, Telenet of South Florida has failed to respond to Commission staff inquiries, and thus Telenet is in apparent violation of Rule 25-24.835, Florida Administrative Code. Because Telenet has failed to respond to staff inquiries, Telenet's certificate may soon be canceled. In addition, Commission staff has held several conversations with Telenet's attorney, Mr. Floyd Self, regarding Docket No. 970730-TP. Per these conversations, Mr. Self has stated that even he has been unable to contact your company. It appears that without Telenet's participation in Docket No. 970730-TP, the Commission will be unable to move forward with Telenet's Petition for relief. Therefore, I must inform you that Telenet must take the appropriate steps to either move forward with Docket No. 970730-TP, or, withdraw its Petition should Telenet no longer be seeking such relief. If Telenet wishes to move forward with Docket No. 970730-TP, please notify me in writing by November 25, 1998. If Telenet does not respond to this letter, staff will have no choice but to take a recommendation to Agenda to dismiss the case.
