PETITIONER, SUPRA TELECOMMUNICATIONS & INFORMATION SYSTEMS, INC. ("Supra"), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby files and serves this its response and opposition to BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'s ("BellSouth") Motion to Strike Supra's <u>Exceptions\Objections_To Staff Recommendations</u>, and in support thereof states as follows:

1. BellSouth has moved to strike Supra's <u>Exceptions\Objections To Staff</u> <u>Recommendations</u> on the grounds that BellSouth does not believe that exceptions are permitted under Rule 25-22.056(4)(b), Florida Administrative Code, when a hearing has been conducted by a panel of commissioners.

2. BellSouth's motion to strike purports to find support under Rule 25-22.037(2)(b), Florida Administrative Code. However, that rule does not provide a basis for striking Supra's <u>Exceptions\Objections To Staff Recommendations</u>. Rule 25-22.037(2)(b) simply governs motions in general and does not authorize or otherwise provide any basis for striking Supra's filing.
