



1.1 Definitions: (continued)

Calling Card Call - A call billed to a card number issued by a Local Exchange Company.

Cancellation of Order - A customer-initiated request to discontinue processing a service order, in part or in whole, prior to its completion. Cancellation charges will be assessed for each circuit-end or dedicated access line canceled from an order prior to completion by Carrier under the following circumstances: (1) if the LEC has confirmed in writing to Carrier that the circuit-end or dedicated access line will be installed; or (2) if Carrier has already submitted facilities orders to an interconnecting telephone company.

Carrier/Company - Intercontinental Communications Group, Inc., d/b/a Fusion Telecom, also(T) d/b/a Fusion - Trucker Phone, also d/b/a Call-4-Less, unless otherwise specified or clearly(T) indicated by the context.

Collect Call - A billing arrangement whereby the charge for a call may be charged to the called party, provided the called party accepts the charge.

Completed Calls - Completed calls are answered calls on the distance end. Appropriate one minute credits will be issued for incompleting calls billed to a customer when brought to the Company's attention by the customer. These one minute credits do not apply to calls terminating in an answering device.

Credit Card Call - A call billed to a major credit or charge card such as Visa, MasterCard or American Express.

Custom Account Coding - Allows the customer to create tables of unique project and/or account numbers for their private use.

Customer - The person, firm, corporation, or other entity which orders or uses service and is responsible for the payment of charges and compliance with tariff regulations.

Customer Provided Equipment - Terminal equipment provided by a customer

Should the Customer not meet the monthly estimated usage, the Company and the Customer will determine whether this is the correct plan for the Customer. In any case, the Customer will not be billed the minimum usage should the estimated monthly billing not be met.

3.8.2 Fusion Residential Direct

(T)

Fusion Residential Direct is available to residential customers for outbound(T) calling via customer-provided local exchange company provided switched access. The minimum Fusion Residential Direct call duration for billing(T) purposes is one (1) minute with additional usage measured and billed in one (1) minute increments. Rates are not mileage sensitive. Customers are billed based on a minimum monthly commitment. Should the Customer not meet the monthly estimated usage, the Company and the Customer will determine whether this is the correct plan for the Customer. In any case, the Customer will not be billed the minimum usage should the estimated monthly billing not be met.

Call charges are billed to the Subscriber rather than to the originating caller. Calls are billed in thirty (30) second increments with a minimum billing period of six (6) seconds. A monthly service charge applies per 800 number. Customers are billed based on a minimum monthly commitment. Should the Customer not meet the monthly estimated usage, the Company and the Customer will determine whether this is the correct plan for the Customer. In any case, the Customer will not be billed the minimum usage should the estimated monthly billing not be met.

3.8.5 Fusion Dedicated 800 Service

(T)

Fusion Dedicated 800 Service is available to Subscribers for incoming calls.(T) Calls originate from any interstate or intrastate location over an 800 number and terminate to a customer-provided dedicated access line. Call charges are billed to the subscriber rather than to the originating caller. Calls are billed in thirty (30) second increments with a minimum call duration for billing purposes of six (6) seconds. A monthly service charge applies per 800 number. Customers are billed based on a minimum monthly commitment. Should the Customer not meet the monthly estimated usage, the Company and the Customer will determine whether this is the correct plan for the Customer. In any case, the Customer will not be billed the minimum usage should the estimated monthly billing not be met.

The Company provides the Customer operator assisted services to aggregator locations on a per call service charge basis. In addition to the per call service charge, mileage-sensitive usage rates apply. The company's operator services are accessible on a twenty-four (24) hour per day seven (7) days per week basis.

The use of the Company's operator services allows the Customer to select from the special call handling or billing arrangements specified within. Call rates and applicable service charges will be assessed to the call originator, the called party's telephone number based on the call type (i.e. operator dialed, collect, third party billed, credit card billed or customer dialed credit card billed without the use of an operator's assistance) initiated by the call originator and the appropriate acknowledgment of other parties, where applicable.

3.8.7 Fusion Debit Card Service - I

(T)

Fusion Debit Card Service is a Debit Card service available to residential and(T) business Subscribers for placing calls while away from home or office. Calls are originated by dialing the 800 access number printed on the card, followed by an account identification number and personal identification number. Debit card accounts maintain a balance which is depleted on a real-time basis as calls are placed. Customers are notified of their remaining account balance at the beginning of each call. Calls may originate from standard residential, business or pay telephone access lines and may terminate to any interstate or intrastate location. Calls are billed in one (1) minute increments. The minimum call duration for billing purposes is one (1) minute. Fusion Debit(T) Card Service is available 24 hours a day, seven days per week. The number of available cards is subject to technical limitations. Cards will be offered to customers on a first come, first served basis.

1. Calls to 500, 700, 800 and 900 numbers
2. Calls requiring the quotation of time and charges
3. Air to ground and High seas services

The marketing vehicle and expiration period is selected by the Sponsor upon joint agreement between the Company and the Sponsor. The Sponsor is responsible for obtaining all necessary permissions for the use of any trade mark, trade name, service mark or other image on the card. The Sponsor may distribute the Carrier's debit card accounts at reduced rates or free of charge to end users for promotional purposes. At the option of the sponsor, these cards may not be replenishable. The Company reserves the right to approve or reject any image and to specify the customer information language and use of the Carrier's trade mark, trade name, service mark or other image on the card.

3.8.9 Travel Card Service

Fusion Travel Card is available to business and residential customers. Calls(T) are originated by dialing a 1-800 access number, followed by the terminating telephone number and personal identification number. Calls may originate from standard residential, business, hotel or pay telephone access lines and may terminate to any interstate or intrastate location. Calls are billed in one minute and additional minute increments. The minimum call duration for billing purposes is one minute. Call charges include per minute usage charges and per call service charges which are subject to commitment discounts.

3.8.10 Directory Assistance

Directory Assistance is available to Fusion Customers. Directory Assistance(T) charge applies to each call to the Directory Assistance Bureau. Up to two requests may be made on each call to Directory Assistance. The Directory Assistance charge applies to each call regardless of whether the Directory Assistance Bureau is able to furnish the requested telephone number.

For services, other than debit card, which allow Customers to access directory assistance, there will be no charge for the first 50 directory assistance calls made per billing cycle from lines or trunks serving individuals with disabilities.

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SECTION 4 - RATES AND CHARGES

4.0 General

If a Customer or Subscriber purchases more than one Fusion service, the cumulative monthly(T) billing for all services will be used to determine the rate for each service. Customers with cumulative billing of less than \$50.00 will be charged a \$5.00 bill processing fee.

4.1 Rate Periods

Day Rate Period

8:00 A.M. to 4:59 P.M. Monday through Friday.

Evening Rate Period

5:00 P.M. to 10:50 P.M. Sunday through Friday

Night/Weekend Rate Period

11:00 P.M. to 7:59 A.M. Sunday through Friday; 8:00 A.M. to 10:59 P.M. Saturday; and 8:00 A.M. to 4:59 P.M. Sunday.

4.2 Usage Charges and Billing Increments

A. Usage Charges

Unless flat rated, usage charges are determined by the time of day rate periods and minutes of use within each rate period. The rate period is determined by the time and day of call origination at the customer's location.

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4.3 Travel Card Service

Calls are billed in one minute and additional minute increments. The minimum call duration for billing purposes is one minute. Call charges include per minute usage charges and per call service charges which are subject to commitment discounts.

4.4 Directory Assistance

All verified handicapped subscribers shall be allowed fifty (50) free Directory Assistance calls per month.

Rates are not mileage sensitive. Customers are billed based on a minimum monthly commitment. Should the Customer not meet the monthly estimated usage, the Company and the Customer will determine whether this is the correct plan for the Customer. In any case, the Customer will not be billed the minimum usage should the estimated monthly billing not be met.

4.12 Fusion Debit Card Service - Sponsor Program

(T)

The Sponsor may distribute the Carrier's debit card accounts at reduced rates or free of charge to end users for promotional purposes. At the option of the sponsor, these cards may not be replenishable.

Surcharge: \$0.25/Per Call

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4.13 Discounts for Hearing Impaired Customers

A telephone toll message which is communicated using a telecommunications device for the deaf (TDD) by properly certified hearing or speech impaired persons or properly certified business establishments or individuals equipped with TDDs for communicating with hearing or speech impaired persons will receive, upon request, credit on charges for certain intrastate toll calls placed between TDDs. Discounts do not apply to surcharges or per call add-on charges for operator services when the call is placed by a method that would normally incur the surcharge.

- A.) **TDD**: The credit to be given on a subsequent bill for such calls placed between TDDs will be equal to applying the evening rate during business day hours and the night/weekend rate during the evening rate period.
- B.) **TRS**: The credit to be given on a subsequent bill for such calls placed by TDDs with the assistance of the relay center will be equal to 50% of the rate for the applicable rate period. If either the calling or called party indicates that either party is both hearing and visually impaired, the call shall be discounted at 60% of the applicable rate.

4.14 Emergency Call Exemptions

The following calls are exempted from all charges: Emergency calls to recognizable authorized civil agencies including police, fire, ambulance, bomb squad and poison control. Fusion will only handle these calls if the caller dials all of the digits to route and bill the call. (T) Credit will be given for any billed charges pursuant to this exemption on a subsequent bill after verified notification by the billed Customer within thirty (30) days of billing.

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SECTION 5 - PROMOTIONS

5.1 Demonstration Calls

From time to time Fusion will demonstrate its services by providing free test calls of up to (T) fifteen minutes duration over its network.

5.2 Promotions - General

From time to time, the Carrier may provide promotional offerings to introduce a current or potential Subscriber to a service not being used by the Subscriber. These offerings may be limited to certain dates, times or locations and may waive or reduce recurring or non-recurring charges.

5.2.1 Competitive Response Promotion

Fusion will, at its discretion, match certain standard or promotional offerings (T) of other interexchange carriers or resellers in order to acquire new Customers. The Customer must demonstrate to the Company's satisfaction that 1) an alternative service offering is valid and currently available from a competing interexchange carrier or reseller and 2) the customer intends to either subscribe to or remain with the competing interexchange carrier or reseller. The Company reserves the right to verify that the alternative offering is an approved tariff on file with the Commission.

5.2.2 Best Rate Guarantee Promotion

Fusion will, at its discretion, match certain standard non-promotional (T) offerings of other interexchange carriers or resellers in order to retain existing accounts. The competing rate must be provided in writing and be listed in an approved tariff on file with the Commission and must result in a lower overall bill for the same service offered by the Company.

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
