AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 15, 1999, this Commission issued Order No. PSC-99-0093-FOF-WS. The portion of the Order concerning surcharges was issued as proposed agency action. However, in the "Notice of Further Proceedings or Judicial Review" section, the Order inadvertently reflected that persons have until February 15, 1999 (thirty-one days), to file a petition for a formal proceeding. This was a scrivener's error, and, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029(2), Florida Administrative Code, substantially affected persons shall have until February 5, 1999 (twenty-one days), to file a petition for a formal proceeding in regards to the proposed agency action portion of this Order.

Order No. PSC-99-0093-FOF-WS is affirmed in all other respects.

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-99-0093-FOF-WS is hereby amended as set forth in the body of this Order. It is further
