PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF ENVIRONMENTAL
COST RECOVERY TRUE-UP FOR PERIODS
ENDING SEPTEMBER 1998 AND DECEMBER 1998

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") hereby Petitions this Commission for approval of FPL's final Environmental Cost Recovery true-up amount of \$570,380 underrecovery for the October 1997 - September 1998 period and \$1,903,369 overrecovery for the period October 1998 - December 1998 and an overrecovery of \$678,159 as the adjusted net true-up amount to be refunded in the January 2000 through December 2000 period. In support of this Petition, FPL states as follows:

1. The final \$570,380 Environmental Cost Recovery underrecovery for the period October 1997 - September 1998, was calculated in accordance with the methodology set forth in Schedule A-2 for the Fuel Cost Recovery Clause, attached to Order 10093 dated June 19, 1981. This calculation and the supporting documentation are contained in the prepared testimony of FPL witness K.M. Dubin, which is being filed together with this Petition and incorporated herein.

2. In Order No. PSC-98-1764-FOF-EI issued December 31, 1998, the Commission approved \$886,387 overrecovery as the estimated environmental cost recovery true-up for the period October 1997 through December 1998. Due to the transition to annual, calendar

year factors, this amount was made up of three parts. First, \$231,557 pertained to the period ending September 1997. Second, \$958,950 was the estimated/actual underrecovery for the period ending September 1998. Third, \$1,613,780 was the estimated actual overrecovery for the period ending December 1998. The adjusted net true-up for the period ended September 1998 is an overrecovery of \$388,570 which is the difference between the actual true-up of \$570,380 underrecovery and the estimated/actual true-up of \$958,950 underrecovery.

3. The final \$1,903,369 Environmental Cost Recovery overrecovery for the period October 1998 - December 1998, was calculated in accordance with the methodology set forth in Schedule A-2 for the Fuel Cost Recovery Clause, attached to Order No. 10093 dated June 19, 1981. This calculation and the supporting documentation are contained in the prepared testimony of FPL witness K.M. Dubin, which is being filed together with this Petition and incorporated herein.

4. The adjusted net true-up for three month period ended December 1998 of \$289,589 is the difference between the actual true-up of \$1,903,369 overrecovery and the estimated/actual true-up of \$1,613,780 overrecovery.

5. The total net true-up to be refunded in the period beginning January 1, 2000 is \$678,159, the sum of \$388,570 for the period ending September 1998 and \$289,589 for the period ending December 1998.

WHEREFORE, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests the Commission to approve the net \$570,380 underrecovery and \$1,903,369 environmental cost recovery overrecovery as the final true-up amount for the periods ending September 1998 and December 1998, respectively, and an overrecovery of \$678,159 as the adjusted net true-up amount to be carried forward to the period beginning January 2000.
