AMERICAN NORTEL COMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S MOTION FOR TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER

American Nortel Communications, Inc. ("ANC"), by and through its undersigned counsel and pursuant to Section 364.24(2), Florida Statutes and Rule 25-22.006(6), Florida Administrative Code, moves the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission') for a temporary protective order in this docket, and as grounds therefor, states as follows:
