Notice is hereby given that the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission will conduct a customer meeting to discuss the application of Tradewinds Utilities, Inc. (Tradewinds or utility) for a new class of service for wastewater-only flat rates in Marion County. The meeting will be held at the following time and place:

All persons who wish to comment are urged to be present at the beginning of the meeting, since the meeting may be adjourned early if no customers are present. The meeting will begin as scheduled and will continue until all the potential customers have been heard.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this meeting is to give potential wastewateronly customers and other interested persons an opportunity to offer comments to the Public Service Commission's Staff regarding the approval of a new class of service for wastewater-only flat rates; as well as, ask questions and comment on staff's approval of the rates, on a temporary basis. The owner or a representative of the utility has also been invited to attend the meeting.

Any person who wishes to comment or provide information to staff may do so at the meetings, orally or in writing. Written comments may also be sent to the Commission at the address given at the end of this notice. Your letter will be placed in the correspondence file of this docket. You may also submit comments through the Public Service Commission's toll-free facsimile line at 1-800-511-0809.

BACKGROUND

Tradewinds Utilities, Inc. (Tradewinds or utility) is a Class C water and wastewater utility located in Marion County. According to the utility's 1997 annual report, the utility provides water services to approximately 421 customers and wastewater service to approximately 257 customers. In its 1997 annual report, the utility reported water revenues in the amount of \$84,259 and wastewater revenues in the amount of \$132,456 with expenses of \$78,286 for water and \$120,302 for wastewater, resulting in net operating income of \$5,973 and \$12,154 respectively. The utility's service area is located in the St. John's River Water Management District. (SJRWMD)

CURRENT AND TEMPORARY RATES

Staff has approved the following rates, on a temporary basis, in Order No. PSC-99-0382-FOF-SU, issued February 23, 1999. These rates are approved, subject to refund, based on further staff review, and the final decision by the Commissioners. The utility's proposed wastewater-only rates are as follows:

General Service Wastewater Rates

Flat Rate Service <u>Classification</u>	Proposed <u>Monthly</u>
Industrial Bldg. (2 bathrooms or less)	\$ 58.95

Industrial Bldg. (Over 2 bathrooms) 261.55 and Quadraplexes
