REQUEST FOR CONTINUED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN MATERIAL PROVIDED IN CONNECTION WITH AUDIT NO. 98-194-4-2

NOW, BEFORE THE COMMISSION, through undersigned counsel, comes Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") and, pursuant to rule 25-22.006 of the Florida Administrative Code and section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, hereby requests continued confidential classification of certain materials provided to the Florida Public Service Commission ("FPSC" or "Commission") Staff ("Staff") in connection with the audit of FPL's Contracts for Computer Work Audit Control No. 96081-4-1 (the "Audit"). In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

- 2. By order number PSC-97-1313-CFO-EI, issued October 22, 1997 in Docket No. 971045-EI, the Commission granted FPL's request for confidential classification of document numbers 07746-97, 07747-97, 07748-97, and 08209-97. The Commission indicated that document 08209-97 would be returned at the expiration of the eighteen month confidentiality period. The Commission also indicated that the other documents would be retained. FPL hereby renews its request for confidential classification of such materials as have been retained by the Commission and for which FPL previously sought confidential classification by its filing dated August 13, 1997.
 - 3. Section 366.093(4) provides in pertinent part:

Records containing proprietary confidential business information which have not been returned at the conclusion of the period set pursuant to this subsection shall no longer be exempt from s.119.07(1) unless the public utility or affected person shows, and the Commission finds, that the records continue to contain proprietary confidential business information. Upon such finding, the Commission may extend the period for confidential treatment for a period not to exceed eighteen months unless the Commission finds, for good cause, that the protection from disclosure shall be for a specified longer period.

FPL submits that the above-referenced information continues to be proprietary confidential business information and should be protected from disclosure pursuant to the public records laws of the State of Florida for an additional eighteen month period.

4. FPL incorporates herein by reference Exhibits A, B, and C of its original request for confidential classification filed August 13, 1997 and upon which order number PSC-97-1313-CFO-EI was based. In support of its request, FPL submits the affidavits of Susan K. Gampfer, Rick Del Cueto, and Julian R. Manduley, included herewith as Exhibit D. There has been no

change in circumstances that should alter the Commission's previous finding that the information is proprietary confidential business information. The same considerations that led to FPL's initial request for confidential classification and the Commission's decision with respect thereto exist today. Further, the subject information continues to be treated by FPL as confidential.

5. For these reasons, FPL seeks continued confidential classification of the information highlighted in Exhibit A. FPL submits that the highlighted information continues to be proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3). Pursuant to section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records laws. Further, pursuant to section 366.093(4), the information that is the subject of this request is exempt from disclosure during the period in which the Commission considers FPL's Request for Continued Confidential Classification.

WHEREFORE, for the above and foregoing reasons, including those set forth in the supporting materials included herewith or incorporated herein by reference, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that its Request for Continued Confidential Classification be granted.
