

Green Pricing R&D Project Seventh Quarterly Report Report Period: First Quarter 1999

PERIOD FOR ACTIVITIES:

The FPL Green Pricing Research and Development Project (GPRDP) was approved by the Commission in Order No. PSC-97-FOF-0528-EG, dated May 7, 1997. This program is designed to allow FPL the flexibility to test FPL customer response to a Green Pricing Initiative. Under the GPRDP, FPL will solicit contributions from its customers to be used to purchase, install, maintain, and operate Photovoltaic (PV) modules on FPL's system.

FPL is proceeding with the design and implementation phases for this project.

ATIVITIES CONDUCTED:

- 1. FPL has completed the system specifications, issued and RFP, evaluated bids, and selected the winning contractor to install the system.
- 2. FPL has completed 3 Customer Workshops on Green Power Pricing and is preparing the quantitative research survey.

CONTRIBUTIONS:

FPL has completed the customer solicitation phase of this effort. The total customer contributions were \$89,428.30.

BUDGET/EXPENDITURES:

The GPRDP has an approved two year cost cap of \$475,000
