Subsequent to our previous correspondence, it has been brought to my attention that in addition to the parcel which you pointed out, there are additional conflicts between the water service area previously granted to Fivelands Investments, Inc., now owned and operated by Charlotte County, and the service area requested by AquaSource, Inc., in their recent application for transfer of the Rotonda West water and wastewater area.

As indicated on the attached, the previously discussed Northwest $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 3, TWP 42S, R20E, as well as the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 27 and the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 34, TWP 41S, R20E all lie within the Charlotte County Utilities service area and are currently served by our Utility.
