On April 21, 1999, Preferred Carrier Services, Inc. ("PCS") notified the Commission that it intended to request a waiver from the Federal Communications Commission from the requirement that it file an IntraLATA Toll Dialing Parity Plan with the Commission. PCS has since determined that it will not seek such a waiver from the FCC at this time.

This letter is to notify the Commission that PCS currently provides telephone service strictly as a reseller and as a non-facilities-based provider of pre-paid basic local exchange service. As is the common practice among providers of pre-paid local service, PCS blocks access to toll calling, including intraLATA toll dialing. PCS does allow the use of long distance calling cards with toll free access or access through an interexchange carrier's toll-free number.

PCS may, in the future, provide its customers with access to intraLATA toll dialing. Before it does so, PCS will provide the Commission with an IntraLATA Toll Dialing Parity Plan for Commission review and approval no less than sixty days prior to offering such access.
