

## JOINT PETITION OF GTE FLORIDA, INC. AND SPRINT-FLORIDA, INC. TO TRANSFER TERRITORIES IN PASCO COUNTY AND TO AMEND CERTIFICATES

GTE Florida, Inc. ("GTE") and Sprint-Florida, Incorporated ("Sprint"), pursuant to Rules 25-4.005 and 28.106.201, Florida Administrative Code, jointly petition the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission" or "FPSC") to modify certain exchange boundaries in Pasco County and to amend the companies' certificates accordingly. In support of this petition, GTE and Sprint state as follows:

- GTE is a telephone company lawfully doing business in the State of Florida, the regulated operations of which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Chapter 364, Fla. Stat. GTE provides service in Florida under FPSC Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 31.
- Sprint is a telephone company lawfully doing business in the State of Florida, the regulated operations of which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Chapter 364, Fla. Stat.
   Sprint provides service in Florida under FPSC Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 22.

- GTE's principal place of business in Florida is 201 North Franklin Street, Tampa, Florida 33602.
- Sprint's principal place of business in Florida is 555 Lake Border Drive, Apopka, Florida 32713.

- 6. GTE and Sprint seek three exchange boundary changes in this petition. The first boundary change is to move a portion of the proposed Homesteads of Saddlewood, Phase II, from the Sprint San Antonio Exchange to the GTE Tampa North Area of the Tampa Metropolitan Exchange. Copies of the proposed service area maps are attached as Exhibit "A".
- 7. Homesteads of Saddlewood Subdivision, Phase II consist of seventy-two residential lots located in the Sprint San Antonio Exchange. The Homesteads of Saddlewood is an established community and it is an extension of the Quail Hollow development that is served by GTE. Currently GTE, with Sprint's acquiescence, is providing service to seventeen subscribers located in the Sprint San Antonio Exchange. Fourteen homes in phase II are currently under construction. Sprint is not providing service to any customers in

this development. Seventeen subscribers would be only nominally affected by modifying the GTE Tampa Metropolitan Exchange to include the entire Homesteads of Saddlewood subdivision since their service is currently provided by GTE.

- 8. The second boundary change is to move part of the proposed Skyridge Terrace subdivision into the GTE Zephyrhills Exchange. Sixteen of the thirty-six residential lots in the Skyridge Terrace subdivision are located in the Sprint Dade City Exchange; the remainder are in the GTE Zephyrhills Exchange. Currently GTE, with Sprint's acquiescence, is providing service to six subscribers located in the Sprint Dade City Exchange. Six subscribers would be only nominally affected by modifying the GTE Zephyrhills Exchange to include the entire Skyridge Terrace subdivision since their service is currently provided by GTE. Sprint is not providing service to any customers in this development. Copies of the proposed service area maps are attached as Exhibit "B".
- 9. The third boundary change is to move part of the proposed Scotland Yards Golf Club from the GTE Zephyrhills Exchange to the Sprint Dade City Exchange. The golf club is currently being served by Sprint and the proposed development around the club would extend into GTE's territory. No subscribers would be affected by modifying the Sprint Dade City Exchange to include the entire

Scotland Yards Golf Club because no houses have yet been built. A Copy of the proposed service area map is attached as Exhibit "C".

- 10. Upon the Commission's approval of the modifications proposed herein, the parties will file the final tariff sheets for administrative approval.
- 11. No financial exchange or consideration was, or shall be, given for this proposed transfer of Certificated Areas. This Joint Application is the only written agreement between the applicants.
- 12. The present boundary lines are generally along section lines and roads and streets. In some cases, the existing boundary lines bisect planned subdivisions located in both companies' territories. In addition, the present boundaries may bisect individual lots in planned subdivisions, rendering provision of service difficult. This application is sought to permit revisions in company boundaries that will not divide planned subdivisions and to move existing boundaries to more readily discernible terrain features. It is intended that the boundary line redefinitions will minimize, if not negate, the future possibility that boundaries in these areas could bisect subdivisions or individual lots, thereby rendering the boundaries more usable in the provision and administration of service.

- 13. Both GTE and Sprint have agreed that the requested transfer of service area is feasible from an economic standpoint and beneficial to the subscribers of both companies.
- 14. Pursuant to FPSC Rule 25-4.005, the required affidavits are attached to this Joint Petition as Exhibit "D", and certify that notice of intention to file the Petition has been given to those parties set forth in the above cited rule.

WHEREFORE, Sprint and GTE request that this Joint Petition be considered, and that the FPSC redefine the boundaries of the Petitioners' Certificates of Public convenience and Necessity as requested in the Petition, and that the FPSC enter an appropriate order to effectuate such a redefinition.
