I have enclosed company check #5182 in the amount \$50.00 for the 1999 regulatory assessment fees, as our agreement states. As a matter of courtesy, I am returning, for the second time, the completed "Service Violation Correction Form," dated September 13, 1999. The operational infractions I was cited for make no sense, because Southern Bell had already disconnected the pay telephone, at my request. This form was probably sent to me in error, due to the fact I am in the process of canceling my certificate. I do not agree with your \$116.50 regulatory assessment fee invoice amount. Our 1998 fees were paid on time by company check #4583, dated January 19, 1999. The PSC deposited my check on January 21, 1999. It cleared my bank on January 25, 1999. A copy of the canceled check is enclosed. The \$16.50 in penalty and interest charges, amounting to 33% of the total, do not apply. If last years fees were still owed, why was I not notified earlier? This enclosed check for \$50.00 represents the last financial obligation I owe the Public Service Commission.

I have already returned my original "Telephone Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity," in my August 23 letter to Ms. Barbara H. Bailey. Southern Bell has turned off the line to the single pay telephone my company has operated. I have retired my Florida Department of Revenue Gross Receipt Tax Certificate, used to pay the phone tax. My payphone is permamentely out of service. I have now fulfilled all my legal obligations to the Florida Public Service Commission, Division of Telecommunications.
