Dear Mr. Gatlin:

The Commission's Division of Records and Reporting notified me that you had written a note on the request for updated information form that stated "I have no phones installed at any location. Considering requesting to cancel certification."

There are two kinds of cancellations. One is a voluntary cancellation in which the company requests cancellation and is in good standing with the Commission. The other is when the Commission cancels a company's certificate for a rule violation. If a pay telephone certificate is involuntarily canceled by the Commission for a rule violation, our rules state that a "new certificate will not be granted to any applicant who has previously had a certificate involuntarily canceled."


Commission records show that your 1998 regulatory assessment fee, which was due February 1, 1999, still has not been paid as of this date. A minimum \$50 fee is due each year by January 30 (or the next working day if the 30th falls on a weekend). If the company pays late, statutory penalty and interest charges are applicable. What this means is that if your regulatory assessment fee is postmarked in July 1999, you will owe \$65.50 (\$50 regulatory assessment fee, \$12.50 penalty, and \$3.00 interest). If your payment is postmarked in August 1999, you will owe \$66.00 (\$50 regulatory assessment fee, \$12.50 penalty, and \$3.50 interest). At that time, you could write the Commission a letter and request voluntary cancellation of your certificate. In addition, you would owe the 1999 regulatory assessment fee, which will become due January 31, 2000. For any given day during a calendar year that a certificate remains active, whether or not the company actually goes into business, that company is responsible for payment of regulatory assessment fees.

Please respond in writing by August 6, 1999 and let me know if you wish to request voluntary cancellation of your certificate. If so, you need to pay the 1998 past due amount and advise when you will pay the 1999 regulatory assessment fee. If the outstanding balance is not paid by August 6, or I do not hear from you by August 6, I will have no choice except to open a docket to involuntarily cancel your pay telephone certificate.

28-24.51 Cancellation of a Certificate.

- (1) The Commission may cancel a company's certificate for any of the following reasons:
 - (a) Violation of the terms and conditions under which the authority was originally granted;
 - (b) Violation of Commission rules or orders;
 - (c) Violation of Florida Statutes; or,
 - (d) Failure to provide service for a period of six (6) months.
- (2) If a certificated company desires to cancel its certificate, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request:
 - (a) Statement of intent and date to pay Regulatory Assessment Fee.
 - (b) Statement of why the certificate is proposed to be cancelled.
- (3) Cancellation of a certificate shall be ordered subject to the holder providing the information required by subsection (2).
