



**TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), pursuant to Rule 28-106.204(5), Florida Administrative Code, moves the Commission for a one business day extension of time within which to prepare and submit rebuttal testimony addressing the direct testimony of Mr. Kent Taylor, a witness for the Florida Industrial Power Users Group ("FIPUG") in this proceeding and, as grounds therefor, says:

1. FIPUG filed and served prepared direct testimony of Kent Taylor in this proceeding on October 18, 1999.

2. For reasons not assigned to FIPUG, but perhaps attributable to the postal service, Tampa Electric did not receive the testimony of Mr. Taylor. Tampa Electric did receive by mail the separate testimony of Mr. Taylor filed on behalf of FIPUG in Docket No. 990607-EI.

3. On the afternoon of October 20, 1999 Tampa Electric learned that Mr. Taylor's testimony had been filed on behalf of FIPUG in this proceeding. Tampa Electric's lawyers were allowed to pick up a copy of Mr. Taylor's testimony after hours that evening, courtesy of the staff of counsel for FIPUG, and this testimony was then faxed to Tampa Electric.

4. On account of the foregoing, Tampa Electric is in need of a one business day extension of time (from Friday, October 29, 1999 until close of business on Monday, November 1, 1999) within which to prepare and submit rebuttal testimony addressing the matters contained

in Mr. Taylor's direct testimony. This request applies only to the testimony of Mr. Taylor in this proceeding, given the above-described circumstances.

5. Tampa Electric has conferred with counsel for FIPUG and is authorized to state that FIPUG does not oppose this motion.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company moves the Commission for a one business day extension of time, through and including Monday, November 1, 1999, within which to file rebuttal testimony only as to the direct testimony of FIPUG's witness Mr. Kent Taylor.
