BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company"), hereby files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Request for Specified Confidential Classification, and states the following.

1. On October 29, 1999, BellSouth filed its Responses to the Staff of

the Florida Public Service Commission ("Staff's") First Set of Interrogatories.

2. BellSouth is now filing a Request for Specified Confidential

Classification for the subject information because the information contained in

Interrogatory Nos. 1, 3, 4, and 6 is proprietary to BellSouth and includes

information containing, among other things, customer specific information.

3. BellSouth has appended to this Request for Confidential Classification as Attachment A a listing of the location of the information designated by BellSouth as confidential.
