

Attached is a letter from Mr. John Manning, Acting President, World Telecommunications d/b/a WTI (WTI), protesting the above subject docket. A review of the Division of Corporations records does indicate that Telenet.com, Inc. is a totally new corporation and that WTI was administratively dissolved for failure to file an annual report effective 9/24/99.

Appearently, a new corporation was formed (Telenet.com, Inc.) since WTI had been administratively dissolved. Therefore, a name change cannot take place due to the formation of a new corporation with new corporate officers.

Pursuant to Section 2.07, Administrative Procedures Manual, staff considers this docket was open erroneously and requests that the docket be closed.

Therefore, since no action is needed from this Commission, please close this docket.

You are hereby notified that World Telecommunications, Inc. objects to Timothy DeDiego's request for a "name change" on Alternative Local Exchange Telecommunications Certificate no. 5686. Timothy S. DeDiego is no longer an officer or director of WTI and is not an agent of the corporation for any purpose. He therefore has no authority to request a name change.


In fact, by requesting this so-called "name change", Mr. DeDiego is in fact attempting to transfer the license, an asset of WTI, to a completely different corporation that is under his control. This is improper as Mr. DeDiego has no legal authority to transfer any of the assets of WTI, including its ALEC license, to another corporation.

Thus, I am respectfully requesting that the Florida Public Service Commission deny Mr. DeDiego's request for a "name change."
