Issue 2: Should the Commission accept the settlement offer proposed by Colorado River Communications, Inc. to resolve the apparent violations of Rule 25-24.485, Florida Administrative Code, Tariffs, and Rule 25-4.043, Florida Administrative Code, Response to Commission Staff Inquiries?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should accept the company's settlement proposal. Any contribution should be received by the Commission within ten business days from the issuance date of the Commission Order and should identify the docket number and company name. The Commission should forward the contribution to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes.

Issue 3: Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: No. With the approval of Issue 2, this docket should remain open pending completion of the refunds, remittance of the \$2,000 voluntary contribution, remittance of the monthly consumer refund reports and remittance to the Commission of all amounts remaining unrefunded for deposit in the General Revenue Fund by March 15, 2000. The reports should be submitted monthly on February 10, 2000 and March 10, 2000. Upon completion of the refunds, remittance of the last monthly refund report, remittance of the settlement payment, and remittance to the Commission of the unrefunded amount, this docket should be closed. The \$2,000 settlement and any unrefunded monies should be forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. If the company fails to pay in accordance with the terms of the settlement offer, the company's certificate will be canceled and this docket closed.
