Issue 2: Based on the results of the subscriber survey, should the Commission order the creation of the new exchange described in the Memorandum of Understanding?

Recommendation: No. Based on the results of the subscriber survey, the Commission should not order the creation of the new exchange described in the Memorandum of Understanding. The survey results, which are summarized in Table A of staff's November 4, 1999 memorandum, indicate that an insufficient number of ballots was received to satisfy the criteria specified in Order No. PSC-99-1133-FOF-TL.
