PETITIONERS MOTION TO USE
TELEPHONE/SPEAKER PHONE FOR OUT OF TOWN WITNESSES

1. Petitioner uses long distance a lot during the course of his business;
 2. When Petitioner could not get his telephone fixed, one of the people calling him was Frank Buford, Attorney in Elkins WV, who told petitioner and GTE Engineer, Ted Kaiser that when he tried to dial Petitioner he got a recording Petitioner's phone was out of order and Petitioner wishes to use Mr. Buford as a witness in the hearing against GTE/PSC;
 3. Further, Petitioner understands that some of the men GTE used on Petitioner's wiring, were from out of town/state and as such, their testimony is vital to Petitioner;
 4. Petitioner does not have sufficient money to pay them to come to the hearing, but has in the past, caused them to be available for testimony by phone, the court has called them and sworn them in, and testimony and cross-examination has taken place;
 5. Petitioner wishes to use this same method for what he believes are for 3-4 people, whose testimony is short, but vital, as they will (a) show when people tried to call Petitioner, they got a recording his phone had been disconnected, when he was supposed to have active service;
- (b) To show by people who worked on the lines to Petitioners house that wires were defective
