- 1. On October 28, 1999, the Commission entered Order No. PSC-99-2134-PCO-EG, and established November 15, 1999 as the due date for direct testimony. By Order No. PSC-99-2286-PCO-EG, issued November 22, 1999, the prehearing officer granted an extension of time until November 30, 1999 to file FPUC's direct testimony.
