Dear Mrs. Bayo:

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, BellSouth and Tennessee Waste Movers d/b/a East Tennessee Phone Service are submitting to the Florida Public Service Commission their amendment to their negotiated agreement for the purchase of BellSouth's telecommunications services for the purpose of resale to end users by Tennessee Waste Movers d/b/a East Tennessee Phone Service. The Commission approved the initial agreement between the companies in Order No. PSC-98-1414 FOF-TP issued October 22, 1998 in Docket 980963-TP.

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Act, the Commission is charged with approving or rejecting the amendment to the negotiated agreement between BellSouth and Tennessee Waste Movers d/b/a East Tennessee Phone Service within 90 days of its submission. The Act provides that the Commission may only reject such an agreement if it finds that the agreement or any portion of the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or the implementation of the agreement or any portion of the agreement with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Both parties aver that neither of these reasons exist as to the agreement they have negotiated and therefore, are very hopeful that the Commission shall approve their amendment.

Amendment to Resale Agreement by and between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and Tennessee Waste Movers d/b/a East Tennessee Phone Service

['his Agreement refers to the Resale Agreement ("the Agreement") entered into by Tennessee Waste Movers d'5/a East Tennessee Phone Service ("East Tennessee Phone Service") and BellSouth Telecommunications. Inc. ("BellSouth") on July 16, 1998. This Amendment ("Amendment") is made by and between East Tennessee Phone Service and BellSouth and shall be deemed effective on the date excented by East Tennessee Phone Service and BellSouth.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual provisions contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged. East Tennessee Phone Service and BellSouth (individually, a "Party" and collectively, the "Parties") hereby covenant and agree as follows:

I. BellSouth and East Tennessee Phone Service are entering into this Agreement for the purpose of deleting the table of Operational Support System (OSS) Rates contained in Exhibit A of their existing Agreement in its entirety and replacing it with the new OSS rates as follows:

OPERATIONAL SUPPORT SYSTEMS (OSS) RATES	Electronic Per LSR received from the CLEC by one of the OSS interactive	Manual Per LSR received from the CLEC by means other than one of the
,	interfaces	OSS interactive interfaces
OSS Order Charge	\$3.50	519.59

In addition to the OSS Charges, applicable discounted service order and related charges apply per the tariff.

2. The Parties agree that East Tennessee Phone Service will incur the mechanized rate for all LSRs, both mechanized and manual, if the percentage of mechanized LSRs to total LSRs exceeds the threshold percentages shown below:

Year	Ratio: Mechanized/Total LSRs
[999	70%
2000	80%
2001	90%

The threshold plan will be discontinued in 2002.

3. The Parties agree that the threshold plan described in Paragraph 2 soove may be superceded by an LSR specific process that would apply the mechanized LSR rate to only those manual LSRs, which cannot be submitted over a mechanized system.

4. The Parties agree that all other provisions of the Agreement, dated July 16, 1998, shall remain in full force and effect.
