The pending change to the 407 area code will be welcomed, provided it doesn't exacerbate the current situation in the Deltona area. As you are certainly aware, Deltona is currently split between the 407 and 904 area codes, and the greater area with DeBary and Orange City all runs together socially and economically. Deltona is also the second largest city in Volusia County.

If you choose to give new residents a new area code, to "solve" the number of 407 numbers available, our area will then have a third area code to contend with. This is the last thing we need here, and if you let your fingers do the walking through our phone book you too can experience the frustration, confusion, and wasted time making sure you have the correct area code.

On the other hand, I would gladly give up the 407 area code for 904 to end the problems here and provide more 407 numbers in Seminole County, plus whatever new area code may be required elsewhere.

We look forward to an end to this problem now that you have an opportunity to deal with it. The public deserves nothing less, and we are looking forward to your favorable consideration and response to these comments.

I am writing to communicate my objections to a PSC committee recommendation for use of 10-digit phone numbers in Orange County and adjacent Central Florida areas. Today's Orlando Sentinel reports that the committee recommends that new phone numbers in the area be issued with a different area code than existing phone numbers. Not only will Central Florida residents have to dial 10 digits in order to place a call, they'll also have to remember the entire 10 digits on a number-by-number basis, with no rhyme or reason to the area code. One might dial one area code to call a neighbor on one side of one's home, and another to call a neighbor on the other side. This will be unnecessarily difficult for the public.

I understand the desire to avoid changing existing phone numbers, especially on the part of businesses (one observer quoted in the Sentinel thought this was great because his office wouldn't need to print new stationary). However, the general public will bear the brunt of this bad decision in the form of confusion and increased difficulty in using a technology that we all depend on. I urge that the PSC reject the committee's recommendation as unworkable, and divide the Central Florida area such that the new area code is assigned on a geographic basis. I, for one, would gladly accept a new area code as an alternative to the committee's proposal.

RE: Proposed changes in the assignment of area codes

Greetings:

The primary question in the proposals for the new area code assignments is whether the first priority is the public need or the industry's convenience and profit. It is obviously the phone company's desire to go the easiest route and assign all of the new numbers to a new area code. This allows them to expand without effort, and also makes it easier to mask long distance charges within what should be one calling area. However, as the name of your organization implies, it is the needs of the public that should take priority. It would cause less confusion and allows for the same number of additional lines if area codes are assigned on a geographic basis, limiting the area covered by each code to a geographically discrete zone. Brevard County would be a natural, pre-existing geographic area for a single area code, preferably with the current 407 area code, with no requirement to dial the area code before the number for calls within the area code.

In addition, the rates the phone company are allowed to charge should make sense. It should not be long distance for local phone calls within a business area, for instance Orlando to Sanford, or Melbourne to Titusville. A couple of years ago, there was a great debate over this matter, and a newspaper article indicated that the phone company had capitulated and that there would no longer be long distance charges from Melbourne to Titusville. It was stated that temporarily there would still be the need to dial the area code for these calls, but that the long distance charge would be dropped and eventually the need to dial the area code would drop as well. This has not happened. The phone company still charges long distance for Melbourne to Titusville, and we still have to dial the area code for these calls. I would like to know why the phone company has not been made to comply with the stated agreement. If the article was in error, and there was no such decision, then you as the Public Service Commission should exercise your powers to direct a public utility for the public good and make this happen and on a given, publicly known deadline.

I want to voice my STRONG opposition to the recommendation to have 2 overlying area codes covering the greater Orlando area now covered by 407. This overlying plan is being tried in Miami, and from everything I hear very few people are satisfied with it. I believe the correct answer is to breakdown the 407 into several area codes with enough growth capability so that it is at least 10 years before another new area code has to be split again. {I really think the answer is to get that phone industry to go to 4 digit area codes, or 4 digit exchanges, such as they did in the Tokyo Japan area about 10 years ago. That truly solved the problem, not just postponed it as you are recommending to do.

What will you do when it have to be divided again ? Have 3, 4 or 5 area code in one city ? That sounds like a very dumb solution.

Please reconsider and find a redivison that satisfies most people, instead of trying to appease all by going with a solution that only offends the people who are not here yet, but in tend all will come to dislike intensely and we all wind up with a broken phone system and a loss of the usefulness of area code that serve one area.

Gentlemen,

I'm writing to make a suggestion regarding the Brevard / Orange / Osceola / Seminole counties telephone area code plan. It may have application elsewhere in the state...

The reason new area codes are being assigned is simple; we're out of valid numbers. Why? Largely because of the tremendous number of mobile, pager and dialup data/FAX lines being gobbled up in huge blocks by carriers.

This suggests a simple solution that I haven't seen mentioned in the press, one that has distinct advantages: Reassign ALL mobile telephone and pager providers to their own new area code, and migrate data/FAX/modem lines to the new area code as necessary, while leaving voice (POTS) lines on area code 407.

The advantage is this: There is a push in the mobile communications industry, including paging, towards "calling party pays" billing. If this is instituted without a distinguishing feature like a separate area code, calling parties may not know they're at risk of paying for sending a page or for mobile service by the airtime minute... While this won't affect providers, it could lead to lots of surprises, unpleasant ones, to callers when they receive their bills.

Designation of a mobile/paging area code will allow callers to *know* that they're at risk of being charged for a call if "calling party pays" is instituted. I've seen at least one paging provider which advertises "free paging for life" in which the pages are *already* being billed to the caller.

Further, modem pools for providers like AOL, Compuserve, and local Internet Service Providers may be placed on the new area code, or migrated to another new one without much impact to users because these numbers are typically autodialed... The human making the call often doesn't even know the number. The phone list would be updated *once* in a user's machine, after which it won't matter if it's 10 digits. Besides, data calls (like calls to AOL) are clearly not going to a mobile number, so callers can easily distinguish modem pools from mobiles in the new area code.

I suspect this sort of plan would find public acceptance, provide sufficient, immediate migration of numbers to the new area code to cover us for a number of years, while simultaneously allowing for "calling party pays" plans in the future.

There are a lot of mobiles, pagers and data/FAX lines out there...

They're largely what caused the problem.

I firmly believe the public will accept that it's only fair to move them to another area code first.



While I can understand the need to add a second area code, I would like to ask you and the Commissioners to make every consideration for the City of Deltona and citizens of southwest Volusia County to exempt Deltona from this proposal

As you know, this area is currently served with the 407 area code, although the remainder of Volusia County is in the 904 area code. Adding a third area code as an overlay to 407 would cause great confusion to the residents and businesses in southwest Volusia. Clearly, the City of Deltona should be exempted from the proposal you are considering in every fashion. Instead, perhaps a recommendation could be added to your proposal to conduct further studies of the need to service southwest Volusia with a single area code.

Thank you for your December 1, 1998 letter to Commissioner Johnson regarding your concerns about the 407 area code relief and its impact on the City of Deltona and citizens of southwest Volusia County. We truly appreciate your interest and concern. Your letter will be placed in the correspondence file for Docket No. 981795-TP.

On August 6-7 and September 24-25, 1998, the Commission held public hearings in Orlando and Melbourne on the issues identified by the parties to the proceeding. The Florida Public Service Commission (PSC) considered the 407 area code relief plans at the December 1, 1998 Agenda Conference. The PSC approved a split boundary extension overlay plan in which (1) Brevard County is split from 407 and placed in a new area code, and (2) the same new area code is simultaneously used as an overlay in the remaining 407 area.

The City of Deltona and Commissioner Wayne E. Gardner expressed several concerns with the 407 area code relief. Therefore, on December 3, 1998, the Commission opened a separate docket (981795-TP) to investigate the telephone exchange boundary issues in south Volusia County (Deltona area). The Commission staff will hold a workshop on January 28, 1999 at the Deltona Community Center at 2:30 pm to provide interested persons an opportunity to comment on the telephone exchange boundary issues.

The Commission will hold a prehearing and a hearing on April 19, 1999, and on May 6, 1999, respectively. The Commission will review the issues at the July 27, 1999 Agenda Conference.

DELTONA - Southwest Volusia's sense of urgency to get a new telephone area code for all the county is not registering in East Volusia.

<p>"It's not even being talked about in East Volusia," at-large County Councilman Big John said. "No one (in East Volusia) really knows about it yet. I personally favor getting a new number right away and getting on with life."

<p>The lack of discussion to develop a single voice to unite the county within one area code may result in Volusia having up to five area codes within five or six years, county communications director Bob Weiss said.

<p>Chamber of commerce officials in Daytona Beach and Ormond Beach are somewhat aware of Southwest Volusia's plight and desires for unification and a new area code, but the issue has not been formally discussed.

<p>"There has been no communication from the west side on this yet," said George Mirabal, president of the Daytona Beach/Halifax Area Chamber of Commerce. "It's not on our front burner, it's not even on the stove yet. But that's not to say we won't talk about it in the future."

<p>The future for Southwest Volusia is May. That's when the Florida Public Service Commission meets in Deltona to discuss local opposition to an overlay plan that will insert a second area code into the 407 region.

<p>Since the 407 area code will run out of number combinations late this year, the PSC ordered an overlay in the region that includes half of Deltona and most of DeBary, two cities divided between 407 and 904.

<p>Local officials oppose the overlay because it means a third area code for the two cities and confusing 10-digit dialing for all calls within the overlay.

<p>A month ago, city and county officials met with PSC staff members and representatives from the two telephone companies that serve Southwest Volusia. They decided to develop a plan for PSC review that would unify the county within the 904 area code.

<p>A voluntary unification requires 407 area code telephone customers to vote on the plan. Officials fear a majority of those would not willingly change their phone numbers.

<p>A failed vote could force Southwest Volusia into the overlay. It is estimated that another overlay would be needed in four years, Weiss said. Deltona and DeBary could then have four area codes within their city limits.

<p>Deltona City Commissioner Wayne Gardner said if Southwest Volusia's 407 re

Thank you for your two letters dated March 11 and March 15, 1999, to Chairman Joe Garcia regarding petitions containing a total of 86 signatures from residents within the City of Deltona who are opposed to bringing a third area code to the City of Deltona. We truly appreciate your interest and willingness to work with the Florida Public Service Commission in this effort. I am responding to your letter because Chairman Garcia is prohibited by Chapter 350, Florida Statutes, from commenting on the merits of matters pending before the Commission.

As you may be aware, the Florida Public Service Commission conducted several public hearings for customers in the Orlando and Brevard County areas regarding the overlay plan for the 407 area code. Upon review of the record and the recommendation of the Commission's staff, the Commission voted on December 1, 1998, to adopt the staff recommendation whereby Brevard County would receive a new area code, and the new area code also would overlay the existing 407 area code in Orange, Seminole, and Osceola Counties. (See Order No. PSC-98-1761-FOF-TL) The Commission felt that this plan would keep the strongest communities of interest intact and provide the longest lives for the old and new area codes.

In addition, the Commission has opened a new docket, Docket No. 981795-TP, in an effort to address the issues that you raise in your letter regarding the Deltona area. The Commission's staff conducted a workshop on Thursday, January 28, 1999, at 2:30 pm at the Deltona Community Center, 980 Lakeshore Drive, Deltona, Florida. We appreciated the City of Deltona's participation in this workshop.



I recently read in the Orlando Sentinel that the telephone company will be starting voluntary 10 digit dialing in your own area code in the near future and as of December 31, 1999, mandatory 10 digit dialing will be instituted. The paper explained that the reason for this is that there are many new numbers and there are not enough numbers available in necessitating 10 digit dialing.

First of all, (1) I think that this is extremely inconvenient to the citizens of Florida. (2) Dialing in your car would be more difficult and more dangerous. In addition, there is multiple automatic dialing devices that would need to be changed, some of which cannot take 10 digits and would be unusable.

Finally, I find it hard to understand how requiring 10 digit dialing would accommodate more telephone numbers because the 10 digit dialing would encompass the same number of possible combinations of phone numbers in that area code. Thus, the number of numbers of area code 407 cannot change whether you add 10 digits to it or let it remain at 7 digits.

I urge the Public Service Commission to rescind this order. I am also going to appeal to the legislature and the Governor of the State of Florida because I think they will agree that this is an extremely unpopular decision.

Another alternative would to be add more area codes. There are possibly 999 area codes. I do not know whether they all have been used but I strongly suspect that there are probably several hundred area codes that still can be used in the country.
