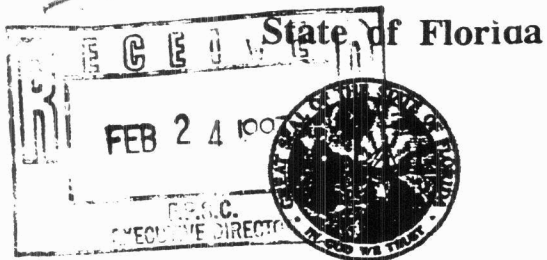

Dear Commissioners:

For several months I have been a customer of TELENET OF SOUTH FLORIDA. I live in Ft. Lauderdale, but many of my phone calls are directed to Miami (where I lived for 27 years) and to the Boca Raton area.

Before learning about TELENET'S lower cost service my phone bills were extremely high. At .25 a call charged by BellSouth, compared to .10 a call, TELENET'S charge, it really changed my monthly bill considerably. Each month, between my husband and myself, we make a MINIMUM of 100 calls. The .15 difference for each call adds up very quickly.

What BellSouth is doing now reminds me of what happened a number of years ago when people first started adding answering machines to their phone system. Southern Bell (as it was then) wanted to add a fee to anyone's bill who had an answer machine.

This was put into effect for a while but after a bitter fight the charge was revoked.

Why did Bell South accept the \$7,000 per month fee to lease Telenet its phone lines in the first place??????
Let BellSouth change its rate if they want to COMPETE, not shoot down an independent company.

Remember the adage: Build a better mousetrap and people will come knocking on your door. Well it seems that Telenet has done just that and now "Ma Bell" is having second thoughts.

Please vote to let Telenet continue in business and show citizens of Florida that "the little guy" still has a chance to succeed...if he or she can "build a better mousetrap."




Dear Commission:


