

Dear Mr. Howell:

This letter is intended to confirm that all issues regarding Fiveland Investments, Inc., (Fiveland) have been resolved and that Certificate No. 571-W has been canceled by the Commission and the above referenced docket closed.

The Commission acknowledged the transfer of Fiveland to Charlotte County by Order No. PSC-99-1220-FOF-WU, issued June 21, 1999, in the above referenced docket. (Copy attached.) However, as you recall, during the pendency of the docket, Charlotte County informed Commission staff that a territory overlap existed between Fiveland and Rotonda West Utility Corporation (Rotonda). That issue was subsequently resolved in Docket No. 981858-WS by Order No. PSC-99-1909-PAA-WS, issued September 27, 1999, which approved the transfer of Rotonda to AquaSource Utility Inc. (Copy also attached.) In that order, the Commission excluded from the transfer the portion of Rotonda's territory which overlapped with that of Fiveland's territory.

Once the protest period had expired on the Rotonda order, staff administratively canceled Fiveland's Certificate No. 571-W and closed Docket No. 981930-WU. The effective date of the cancellation of the certificate, however, is the date of transfer to Charlotte County on December 30, 1998. Note that Order No. PSC-99-1220-FOF-WU which acknowledged the transfer of Fiveland to Charlotte County also acknowledged that the utility had no outstanding regulatory fees due the Commission. And, since the utility became non-jurisdictional in 1998, the Commission has no need for a 1998 Annual Report. As a consequence, this letter is your authority to ignore any correspondence you may have received indicating that such a report is due.
