identify the docket number and company name. The Commission should forward the contribution to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. If any of the companies listed on page 5 fail to pay in accordance with the terms of the Commission Order, that company's certificate should be canceled administratively.

Issue 2: Should these dockets be closed?

Recommendation: Yes. If the Commission approves staff's recommendation in Issue 1, the docket for each company listed on page 5 should be closed upon receipt of the \$100 contribution or cancellation of the certificate.
