Revision of Recommendation in Docket No. 991632-WS filed March 16, 2000, for the RE:

March 28, 2000 Agenda Conference

Pursuant to Standard Operating Procedures 1607, staff is providing written notice that we intend to request an oral modification to staff's recommendation for Docket No. 991632-WS filed March 16, 2000, for the March 28, 2000, Agenda Conference. Staff is requesting a minor revision to staff's recommendation in Issue 1. Staff does not believe that this revision substantively changes the recommendation. However, staff believes that the modification will provide clarification.

Staff is requesting that the Recommendation to Issue 1 be modified to read as follows:

**RECOMMENDATION:** Yes. Dana's Motion for Extension of Time for filing of the initial rates and charges information along with supporting engineering, operational, and financial data should be granted. Staff further recommends that the utility establish at the time of any proposed transfer that it meets the requirements for a temporary waiver by filing a petition for temporary waiver, if necessary, or file the information. Further, staff is recommending that staff's discussion of Issue 1 in the recommendation, page 6, paragraph 2, last sentence, include the modification stated above. Staff believes that modifying the recommendation and proceeding to the agenda conference is in the best interest of all concerned.
