RE: DOCKET NO. 991788-EG - Approval of demand-side management plan of Florida Power & Light Company.

Issue 1: Should Florida Power & Light Company's (FPL) Demand-Side Management (DSM) Plan be approved, including approval for cost recovery? Recommendation: Yes. FPL's DSM Plan should be approved because the Plan: 1) meets the objectives of Rule 25-17.001 and FEECA; 2) contains programs that appear to be cost effective and directly monitorable; 3) appears to meet FPL's numeric conservation goals; and 4) appears to adhere to the stipulation between FPL and LEAF. Expenditures on FPL's proposed R&D programs should be capped at the levels contained in FPL's Plan.

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Issue 2: Should Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) be required to submit detailed program participation standards?

Recommendation: Yes. FPL has recently filed proposed program participation standards with staff. Staff should administratively approve the program standards if they conform to the description of the programs contained in FPL's approved DSM Plan.

Issue 3: Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: Yes. This docket should be closed upon issuance of a Consummating Order unless a person whose substantial interests are affected by the Commission's proposed agency action files a protest within 21 days of the issuance of the order.
