Request for cancellation of AAV certificate for TWC Cable Partners by Cox Communications Pensacola, Inc.

Dear Ms. Bayo:

Pursuant to Rule 25-24.735(2), Florida Administrative Code, Cox Communications Pensacola, Inc., (Cox Communications) requests cancellation of Alternate Access Vendor (AAV) Certificate No. 4033, for service provider TWC Cable Partners. Additionally, Cox Communications respectfully requests that the Commission transfer an existing Regulatory Assessment Fee credit of \$50.00 from the account of Cox Florida Telecom, L.P. d/b/a Cox Communications, Certificate No. 4036, to TWC Cable Partners.

The overpayment of Regulatory Assessment Fees on the Cox Florida Telecom Certificate occurred during the first quarter of 2000. On January 21, 2000, Cox Communications submitted a check for \$177.14 for payment of outstanding 1999 and 2000 Regulatory Assessment Fees for Cox Florida Telecom.
