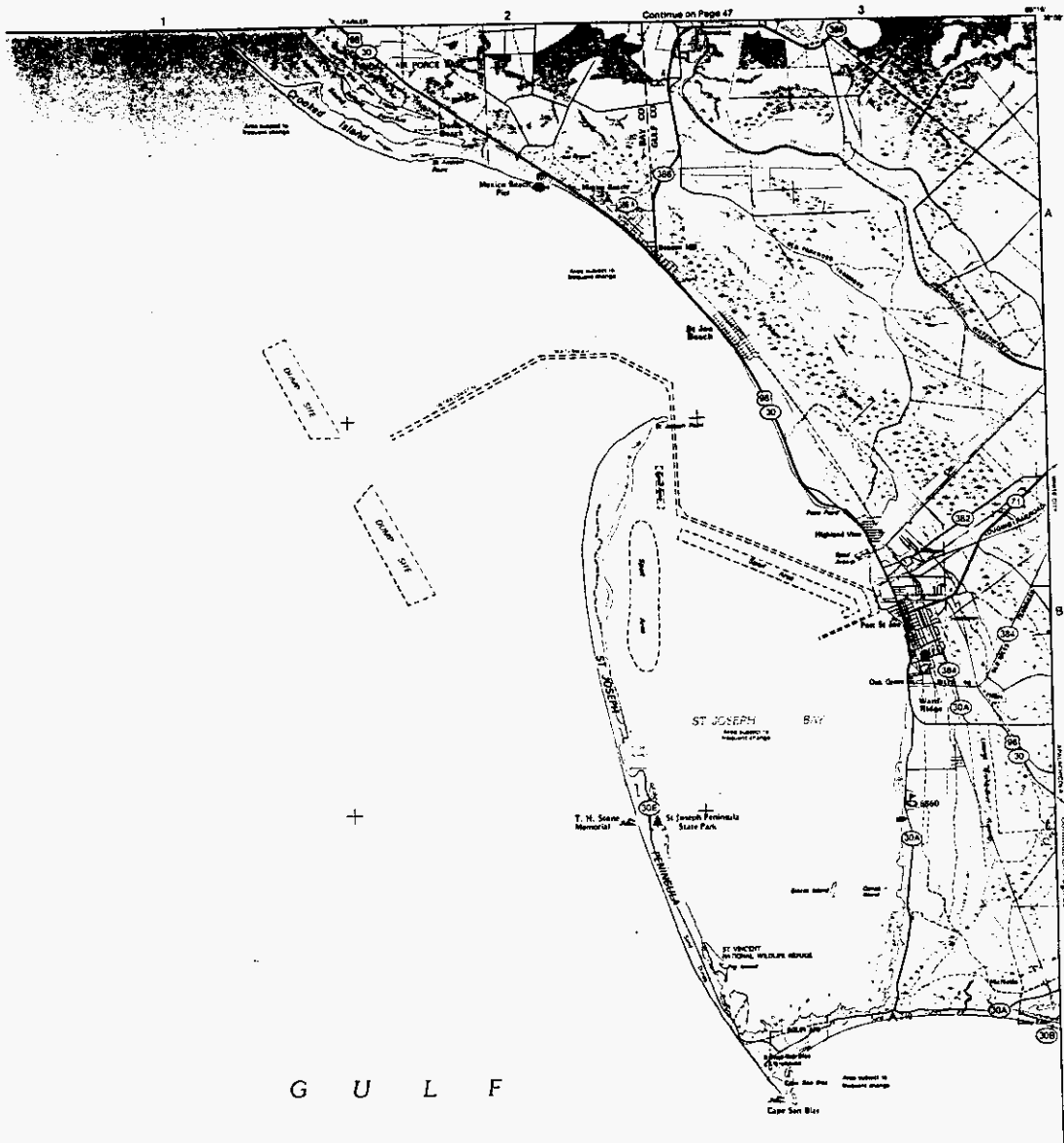

MEMBERSHIP FEE

A \$5.00 Membership Fee is required for all new Members of the Cooperative.

DEPOSIT REQUIRED

The required deposit shall be equal to the estimated total charges for two months' anticipated usage, but not less than \$175. In each case of a cash deposit accepted, the Cooperative shall issue to the consumer a receipt showing what the deposit is for and the date paid. No deposit shall be required if the applicant provides evidence of good credit history from his or her former electric utility supplier.

After one year the deposits may be returned if, in the opinion of the Cooperative's general manager, the member is not delinquent, has promptly paid all service charges during the year and has not violated the policy of the Cooperative as to worthless checks and drafts. Upon the consumer's request, the Cooperative shall refund the consumer's deposit and membership fee when service has been disconnected and when the consumer's final bill has been paid.

BILLING PERIOD

Bills for regular service will be rendered monthly from meters read by Cooperative personnel. Bills are due and payable upon receipt of the bill by the consumer.

DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS

1. Any account not paid within 20 days from date of bill will be considered delinquent.
2. If the account has not been paid within 20 days from date of bill, a collector will be dispatched to collect the amount past due. The customer may also be provided a five (5) working days' written notice of discontinuance separate and apart from any bill for service.

DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS (continued)

3. The Cooperative may discontinue service if payment is not received after diligent attempts to have the customer comply, including a lack of response by the customer to the Cooperative's five (5) working days' written notice of discontinuance of service.
4. Any account that has been disconnected for non-payment will be required to pay the Cooperative for all electrical service rendered up to and including the kilowatt hour reading on the meter when disconnected before electric service will be restored, plus all service charges for disconnecting and reconnecting.
5. Any meter pulled for non-payment shall be charged a \$25.00 reconnect fee during normal working hours, and \$40.00 at all other times.
6. In the event any consumer has established a record of delinquent payments, the customer will be required to provide additional security deposit equal to two (2) months' estimated charges. A "record of delinquent payments" is defined as: three (3) payments not received in a timely fashion during the past twelve (12) months.

SERVICE CHARGES

1. A twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) service charge for each temporary service at a new location.
2. A twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) service charge for each conversion of temporary to permanent service.
3. A twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) service charge for each connection or reconnection at an existing service location.

SERVICE CHARGES

4. A twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) service charge for each collection call or disconnection of service for non-payment of bill.
5. If the Florida Public Service Commission makes a finding of illegal diversion of electricity, the customer shall pay charges for the Cooperative's labor to rectify the account, plus all applicable charges for a reasonable estimate of the energy used.
6. Meter Damage: Charge for the meter, material and Cooperative's labor to repair or replace meter equipment.
7. A service charge of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) or five percent (5%) of the amount of the check, whichever is greater, shall be charged to the customer's bill for electrical service for each check dishonored by the bank upon which it is drawn.
8. A twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) service charge for a name change in billing where it is necessary to establish a new ID number and a new capital credit number. There will be no charge for an address change.

OTHER SERVICES & CHARGES

1. Contribution in Aid of Construction

Residents: Actual construction costs for the subaqueous distribution line and all distribution facilities, transformers and meters necessary to establish electrical service on Black's Island will be recovered through a one-time assessment on each lot sold.

If a tampered meter is discovered, the account is considered past due and all monies due will be collected and a \$25.00 service charge added. Also, if meter is destroyed, the cost of a new meter will be charged to the consumer.

4. Meter Testing Charge

A meter will be tested upon request by a consumer without making any service charge. If a consumer requests more than one meter test on the same meter in a twelve (12) month period, there will be a service charge of \$25.00 if the meter is found to be accurate. If the meter is more than 2% plus (+) or minus (-) out of calibration, there will be no service charge.

The Energy Charge shall be equal to the average energy charge rate incurred by the Cooperative for wholesale power purchased by the Cooperative, plus a pro-rated share of the demand charges incurred by the Cooperative for wholesale power purchased by the Cooperative, times the Consumer's metered kWh of electrical energy usage.

For Consumers taking service under Rate Schedule GSD-1, General Service Demand, the charges pursuant to this Schedule WPCR shall be as follows.

The Demand Charge shall be equal to the average monthly demand charge rate incurred by the Cooperative for wholesale power purchased by the Cooperative, adjusted to reflect estimated differences in the Consumers' billing kW and the billing kW paid by the Cooperative, times the Consumer's metered billing kW during the month.

The Energy Charge shall be equal to the average monthly energy charge rate incurred by the Cooperative for wholesale power purchased by the Cooperative times the Consumer's metered kWh of electrical energy usage.

(c) The Consumer agrees that if, at any time the rate under which the Seller purchases electric energy at wholesale is modified, the Seller shall make a corresponding modification in the rate for service hereunder.

3. Continuity of Service

The Seller shall use reasonable diligence to provide a constant and uninterrupted supply of electric power and energy; but if such supply shall fail or be interrupted, or become defective through an act of God, of the public enemy, or by accident, strikes, labor troubles, or by action of the elements, or inability to secure right-of-way, or other permits needed, or for any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the Seller, the Seller shall not be liable therefor.

4. Membership
