NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

The action proposed herein is preliminary in nature and will not become effective or final, except as provided by Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code. Any person whose substantial interests are affected by the action proposed by this order may file a petition for a formal proceeding, as provided by Rule 25-22.029(4), Florida Administrative Code, in the form provided by Rule 25-22.036(7)(a) and (f), Florida Administrative Code. This petition must be received by the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, by the close of business on <u>September 27, 1995</u>.

In the absence of such a petition, this order shall become effective on the day subsequent to the above date as provided by Rule 25-22.029(6), Florida Administrative Code.

Any objection or protest filed in this docket before the issuance date of this order is considered abandoned unless it satisfies the foregoing conditions and is renewed within the specified protest period.

If this order becomes final and effective on the date described above, any party substantially affected may request judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or by the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. ORDER CANCELING PAY TELEPHONE CERTIFICATE

BY THE COMMISSION:

Providence Telesys, Inc., holder of Pay Telephone Certificate (PATS) of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 4272, has requested the cancellation of PATS Certificate No. 4272. Providence Telesys has complied with the provision of Rule 25-24.514(2), Florida Administrative Code, by providing adequate notice in writing of its request for cancellation of its PATS certificate and by submitting its regulatory assessment fees (RAFs) for 2000. Accordingly, we find it appropriate to cancel PATS Certificate No. 4272, effective July 10, 2000.

Providence Telesys shall return its certificate to this Commission. In addition, under Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, certificate holders must pay a minimum annual Regulatory Assessment Fee of \$50 if the certificate was active during any portion of the calendar year. A RAFs Return notice for 2000 has been mailed to Providence Telesys. Neither the cancellation of its certificate nor the failure to receive a RAFs Return notice for the year 2000 shall relieve Providence Telesys from its obligation to pay RAFs for 2000.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Providence Telesys, Inc.'s Certificate No. 4272 to provide Pay Telephone services is hereby canceled, effective July 10, 2000. It is further

ORDERED that Providence Telesys, Inc. shall return its certificate to this Commission and remit Regulatory Assessment Fees for the year 2000. It is further
