

SPRINT'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Sprint Communications Company Limited Partnership ("Sprint"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Administrative Code, hereby files this Request for Confidential Classification, and states:

- On August 24, 2000, Staff filed its Seventh Set of Interrogatories to Sprint. In Interrogatory No. 42, Staff requested Sprint to explain "how the 'actual work time' was developed" as referenced in Mr. McMahon's Refiled Rebuttal Testimony at page 10, lines 11-16. On September 12, 2000, in response to Staff's interrogatory and Staff's Eighth Request for Production of Documents, Sprint agreed to provide Staff with a CD-ROM that contains proprietary confidential information of Sprint. The CD-ROM, which has been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting, consists of the contracts Sprint has with contractors in Florida to remove load coils and bridged taps.
- Sprint hereby files this Request for Confidential Classification because the information contained in the CDinformation and NUMBER-DATE ROM includes vendor-specific pricing

confidential business information. This information reflects vendor-specific pricing negotiated by Sprint. Public disclosure of this information would impair Sprint's ability to contract for goods and/or services on favorable terms. Pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, such information is classified as proprietary confidential business information, which is exempt from the Open Records Act.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, Sprint respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential proprietary business information that is not subject to public disclosure.
