**Proposed Services** 

#### PROPOSED SERVICES

Dynamic Telcom Engineering I, LLC ("DTE") requests authorization to offer resold and facilities-based telecommunications services to business and residential end users throughout the State of Florida. DTE's local exchange services will include basic dial tone, operator services, directory assistance and emergency 911 services. DTE's exchange access services will include, without limitation, terminating access to enable other carriers to terminate traffic to the DTE networks and originating access to enable DTE customers to access the interexchange networks of other carriers on a non-discriminatory basis.

To the extent DTE resells telecommunications services, it will purchase digital trunking services from an existing incumbent or competitive carrier for local service and purchase service from an interexchange carrier for long distance service. To the extent DTE provides facilities-based services, it will connect its own switching centers to another carrier's local switching facilities using trunks leased from another carrier.

DTE also plans to provide Operator Services and Directory Assistance through subcontracts with long distance and local carriers. DTE will staff its own call center for providing service, answering customer calls and resolving customer concerns. DTE may subcontract for customer directory listings and plans either to subcontract for, or to provide through its own switch, 911 and E911 services.

As a newly formed start-up, DTE is currently not providing telecommunications services in any jurisdiction. DTE, however, intends to construct its telecommunications residential networks in a variety of states, potentially including Arizona, California, Colorado, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia and Washington.
