Your e-mail will serve as confirmation of withdrawal of this item from the 12/19 agenda, however, the 12/7 recommendation will remain in the docket file.

Regarding whether this should remain a consent item, my understanding of SOP 1607, is this should not be a consent item. According to SOP 1607, " The "implied recommendation" here is that the petition, application or request should be approved, and that the docket should be closed after the appropriate period for protest or motion-for-reconsideration has expired." You told me that the application has already been approved and that this was a portion of the docket that needed to be dealt with. Because action has already taken place in this docket it seems unlikely that you will be able to change the docket title. Two other options are to open a new docket or place on the regular agenda.
