

GENERAL LOCATION AND PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Authorities to the proposed electrical power plant is estimated to produce 529 MW of net generating capacity. The proposed plant is to be located in the City Authoritide, Polic County, Forida. The Project site is located approximately 1.5 miles southwest of downtown Authoritide and approximately 37 miles en of format Bay. The proposed unit consists of two combustion turbine generators, two matched heat recovery steam generators, and one steam turbing generator. The proposed plant is estimated to commence commercial operation in the second quarter of 2003.
